An easy-to-use set of tools for language learning, job orientation and labour market inclusion of migrants!



The Job Language Kit is a language tool with educational and informative character developed as a multimedia product creating and improving language and communication skills on employment matters through language learning approaches in diverse forms – paper-based materials, interactive tools and a mobile app, available via the website www.workit-project.eu.

The product will be provided for free to migrants and organisations working for the language training and job coaching of migrants.



Current Activities

In the period April–June 2017, the WorkIt partners will organise training workshops and exploitation seminars in all partner countries in order to present and spread the WorkIt products.

Training workshops will be organised for (volunteer) language educators working with migrants in order to train them how to apply the Job Language Kit and its on- and offline applications within a language learning environment.

The goal of the exploitation seminars is to present the project products and results and create networking opportunities between relevant stakeholders in the area of language training and integration of migrants. The seminars will be run for organisations working with migrants, adult education providers, language providers, migrant communities, NGOs and organisations dealing with integration issues, volunteer organisations working with migrants, language and VET providers, employers' associations, workers unions, job coaching providers, policy-makers, etc.

What's next...

The final conference of the project will take place on June 7th, 2017 in Rotterdam, The Netherlands. Representatives from migrant communities, organizations working for migrants, stakeholders, language educators and volunteers will be invited to attend the conference and share their impressions from the WorkIt products and activities. During the conference, good practice examples for integration of migrants through language learning will be presented and the participants will share their experiences.
